MINUTES OF THE 6th MEETING OF PROJECT APPROVAL BOARD (PAB) HELD ON 19.09.2012 AT 10:30 AM TO CONSIDER PROPOSALS UNDER THE MODEL SCHOOL SCHEME.

6th meeting of the Project Approval Board (PAB) for the Model School Scheme was held on 19.09.2012 in the Ministry of HRD under the Chairpersonship of Secretary (SE&L) to consider proposals from the State Governments of Gujarat, Jharkhand, West Bengal, Rajasthan, Andhra Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh. As the representatives from the State Govt. of Jharkhand could not participate in the meeting, the proposal of the State was not considered. List of participants is appended.

2. Initiating the meeting, Joint Secretary (SE.I), D/o SE&L welcomed the participants and invited the State representatives to present their proposals.

3. Uttar Pradesh

3.1. Secretary, Secondary Education, Government of Uttar Pradesh made a presentation on the proposal of 89 model schools to be set up in as many Educationally Backward Blocks (EBBs) in the State. (Detailed presentation at **Annexure-I**)

3.2 While submitting the progress of earlier sanctioned 148 model schools, the State Government informed that the construction of these schools is in progress and the school buildings are likely to be completed and made functional by April, 2013.

3.3 The appraisal team pointed out that out of 89 proposals, 6 model schools have already been sanctioned in the State earlier and 3 proposals are for Non-Educationally Backward Blocks. They further pointed out that the proposed site of the model schools in large number of blocks is at a distance of more than 5 kms. from the block headquarters.

3.4 PAB observed that though the Scheme broadly lays down 'block headquarters' as location for these schools, it has been approving

proposals within a distance of 5 Kms from the headquarters and in cases where the State has been able to substantiate the fact that despite its best efforts it is unable to locate the school within the 5 Kms, the PAB has granted exceptions and sanctioned schools even beyond the distance of 5kms.

3.5 The State Government submitted that in a State like UP with high density of population and availability of land being scarce, the PAB may consider making an exception to approve proposals where schools are being located within 8 Kms. from Block headquarters and where the availability of land is more than 3.5 acres.

3.6 While agreeing with the submission, the State Government was advised to explore the location of remaining model schools near the block headquarters and in cases they find it difficult to have a suitable location within 08 kms. from the block headquarters, such proposals should be re-submitted to the Ministry after due diligence and with proper justification on selection of such sites.

3.7 The State Government further raised the issue of applicability of State Schedule of Rates for construction of model schools. It was clarified that with the current provision under the Scheme, it is not possible to consider the request of the State Government; however, efforts are being made to resolve the issue.

3.8 The PAB approved 45 model schools in as many blocks with project cost of Rs. 3.02 crore per school with 2.5% MMER. The list of 45 blocks is at **Annexure-II**.

4. ANDHRA PRADESH

4.1 Director, RMSA Government of Andhra Pradesh made a presentation on the proposal of 311 model schools to be set up in as many EBBs in the State. It was stated that out of 737 EBBs, model schools in 355 EBBs have already been sanctioned. The present proposal is for 311 schools to be set up from classes from VI to XII with English as the medium of instruction. (detailed presentation at **Annexure-III**)

4.2 It was pointed out that the State is yet to release its State Share for these 355 schools. The PAB expressed concern in this regard and requested the State Government to expedite the release of State share. The State Government was further informed that unless the State share for these 355 schools is released, it will not be possible to release any further Central Share to the State.

4.3 The State Government informed that the process for recruitment of teachers for these 355 schools is already underway and the State proposes a separate cadre for these model schools. The PAB suggested the State Government may consider conducting leadership programme for these teachers and Head Masters in collaboration with National University of Educational Planning and Administration (NUEPA).

4.4 The State Government submitted that an amount of Rs.8 lakh to 10 lakh has been notified for process of land acquisition for this purpose and requested for financial support in this regard. The PAB informed that in view of the provisions of the Scheme it is not possible to consider the request of the State Government

4.5 The appraisal team pointed out that the site of model school in many blocks is beyond 5 kms of block headquarters. The PAB suggested that the State Government may reconsider selection of sites for these model schools within a distance of 5 kms from the block headquarters. The appraisal team further submitted that the location of site in 236 blocks is within 5 kms from the block headquarters. However, out of these, availability of land in 59 blocks is less than 5 acres and in case of 2 blocks namely Tekulapally and Chandrugonda blocks of Khammam district, the availability of land is 3.25 acres and 2.35 acres respectively. The State Government was requested to explore the possibility of identifying adequate land in these blocks.

4.6 After considering the proposal, the PAB approved model schools in blocks having minimum availability of 3.5 acres of land and which are within the 5 kms from the block headquarters. For remaining blocks, the State Government was requested to re-submit the proposal after due diligence with detailed justification for locating the schools beyond a distance of 5 km from the block headquarters.

4.7 Accordingly, 234 model schools in as many blocks with project cost of Rs. 3.02 crore per school with 2.5% MMER were approved. The list of 234 blocks is at **Annexure-IV**.

5. GUJARAT

5.1 Joint Director, Commissionerate of Schools, Government of Gujarat made a presentation on the proposal for 02 model schools to be set up in as many EBBs in the State. The schools will have classes from VI to XII. Gujarati and English will be the medium of instruction. Land has already been identified for construction of Model School in these blocks. (Detailed presentation at **Annexure-V**)

5.2 The State Government informed that out of 85 EBBs in the State, Model schools in 83 blocks have already been sanctioned. So far model schools sanctioned to Education Department, the construction work has been allocated to Gujarat State Road and Building Department and the tender has been floated for 12 model schools.

5.3 The appraisal team pointed out that the availability of land in both these blocks is above 5 acres, however the State has not indicated the distance of the proposed site of these blocks from the block headquarters. The State Government representative submitted that in Meghraj Block the proposed location is within 3 kms from the block headquarters. However, in Gandhidham block, the proposed location is at a distance of 12 km from the block headquarters. He further submitted that as most of the land belongs to Kandla Port Trust and also as it is an industrial area, it is not possible to locate the school within a distance of 5 km from the block headquarters.

5.4 PAB suggested that the State Government may approach the Port Authority again with the request to allocate suitable land for the model school and also asked JS(SE) to take up the matter with the Ministry of Shipping, Government of India.

5.5 After considering the proposal, the PAB approved a model school in Meghraj Block with project cost of Rs. 3.02 crore with 2.5% MMER.

For Gandhidham block, the PAB decided that if the efforts to get suitable land from the Port Authority do not materialize, the process for approval of model school in this block be processed in file for approval.

6. RAJASTHAN

6.1 The State Project Director, RMSA, Government of Rajasthan made a presentation on the proposal for 40 model schools to be set up in as many EBBs in the State. All the schools will have classes from VI to XII and English will be the medium of instruction. (Detailed presentation at **Annexure-VI**)

6.2 The State representative submitted that out of 186 EBBs, model school in 134 EBBs has already been sanctioned and the construction agency has already been identified for these blocks. Construction process in 16 blocks is already under way and an amount of Rs.91.84 crore has been released to the implementing agencies.

6.3 The State Government raised the issues of linking of construction cost of model schools with BSR rates and price index as prevailing unit cost under model schools is not viable. The State Government also raised the issue of provisioning of cost of compound wall. It was also informed by the State Government that the State PWD, which is the implementing agency for construction of model schools, is charging 13% pro-rata charge for carrying out the construction resulting in increase in construction cost.

6.4 The PAB clarified that it is not appropriate to link BSR rates and price index with the unit cost of model schools in view of the existing provision under the Scheme. The State Government has to bear any additional cost over and above the Scheme norms for which the State representative agreed. As regards the issue of compound wall, Secretary (SE&L) suggested that the State should consider provision of green fencing around the schools. Joint Secretary(SE.I), D/o SE&L suggested to dovetail the funds from other schemes such as Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MNREGA).

6.5 JS&FA, D/o SE&L raised the issue of slow pace of expenditure at State level resulting in parking of funds and requested the State Government to increase the pace of construction, so that funds are utilized for the purpose for which these are sanctioned. PAB expressed concern and informed the State Government that it is not possible to release any further Central Share unless substantial funds have been utilized.

6.6 The appraisal team submitted that out of 40 blocks, locations proposed in 14 blocks are beyond 5 km from the block headquarters. In the remaining 26 blocks, which are within 5 km of block headquarters, the availability of land in two blocks namely Chhoti Sadri and Pratap Garh blocks in Chittorgarh district is 4.94 acre.

6.7 After considering the proposals, the PAB approved model schools in 26 blocks including Chhoti Sadri and Pratap Garh blocks with project cost of Rs. 3.02 crore with 2.5% MMER. Release of funds shall be subject to utilization of funds available with the State Government. The list of 26 blocks is at **Annexure-VII**.

7. WEST BENGAL

7.1 Secretary (School Education), Government of West Bengal made a presentation on the proposal for 19 model schools to be set up in as many EBBs in the State. All the schools will have classes from VI to XII and will be affiliated with the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education. (Detailed presentation at **Annexure-VIII**)

7.2 The State representative informed that out of 87 EBBs, model school in 52 blocks have already been approved. The State PWD has been identified as implementing agency and construction in 17 blocks is in process. He also informed that though it is not possible to carry out the construction process within the prescribed unit cost, the State Government is ready to bear the additional expenditure over and above the scheme norms.

7.3 It was further submitted by the State Government that there will be a common cadre of the teachers for these model schools and no test will be carried out for selection of students for the schools. The schools will be set up on Kendriya Vidyalaya template having a total coverage area of 3,120 sq.m.

7.4 The appraisal team submitted that they have appraised 12 proposals only as the 7 proposals have not yet been received from the State Government. Out of these 12 proposals, location in 04 blocks is within 5 kms, in 05 blocks is within 5-8 kms and in remaining 03 blocks is within 10-15 kms from the block headquarters. Further, availability of land in all these blocks is above 3.5 acre. The State Government submitted that it is not possible to acquire adequate land in and around the block headquarter due to high population density in the State and also large tracts of cultivable land. PAB requested the State Government to re-submit the proposal with regard to 03 locations beyond 08 kms from the block headquarters after carrying out due diligence and with proper justification accompanied by the copies of the correspondence with the District Authorities.

7.5 After considering the proposal, the PAB approved model schools in 09 Blocks with project cost of Rs. 3.02 crore with 2.5% MMER. The list of 09 blocks is at **Annexure-IX.**

8. The PAB also ratified approval of recurring grants for the year 2012-13 for model schools in respect of Tamil Nadu (Rs.12.3103 crore), Madhya Pradesh (114.0081 crore) and Punjab (Rs. 13.7333 crore).

9. The meeting ended with a word of thanks to the Chair.
